For payment of all school related expenses

PAYING IN PERSON:

- Payment can be made at the school office Monday-Friday from 8:00am - 3:00pm
- EFTPOS, Cash and Cheques are accepted

CENTREPAY: Centrepay is a voluntary bill paying service available to families who receive a Centrelink payment. Visit <https://www.servicessaustralia.gov.au/centrepay> or the school office for more information

Contact the school for further information regarding BPOINT.

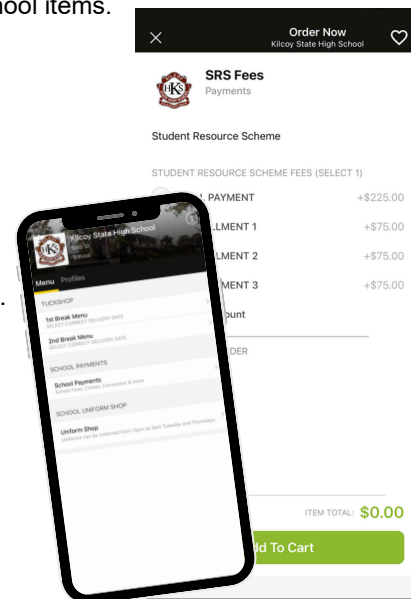

QKR APP (BY MASTERCARD):

The Qkr App is a secure and easy way for families to pay for various school items.

On the Qkr App you can pay Student Resource Scheme (SRS) and Laptop4Hire fees, order tuckshop and purchase uniforms.

QParents

QParents is a secure online platform where you have access to all your child's information.

When invoices are emailed home, parents can log on to the QParents app and see any outstanding payments on your child's account.

You can then pay the invoice with a credit/debit card with card.

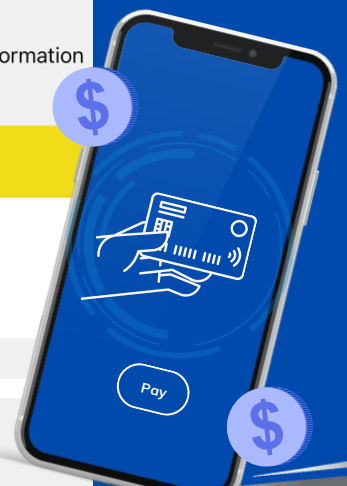
