KILCOY STATE HIGH SCHOOL will receive - \$ 204 170

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard for Literacy and Numeracy for their year level to 100%
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands
- Embed and evidence based plan, developed by the school to address the specific learning needs of students not meeting the National Minimum Standard for Literacy and/or Numeracy.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in core learning areas
- Enable every Year 12 student (100%) to attain either the Queensland Certificate of Education or Queensland Certificate of Individual Attainment

Our initiatives include

- Implementing a whole school approach to provide a continuum of literacy/numeracy support with personalised teaching and intervention that meets the needs of all students
- Implementing a whole school approach to teaching Reading and Writing strategies
- Building teachers capability to teach 'Thinking Skills' enabling students to access higher order thinking strategies across all year levels
- Revisiting and revising the school pedagogical framework in order to continue embedding a shared language of teaching and learning across the school
- Engaging in the Pilot Project 'New Pedagogies for Deep Learning' – researching, developing and implementing programs that provide access to higher order thinking skills for all students
- Continuing to support professional learning teams across the school promoting shared learning, planning and reviewing of curriculum and teaching practice
- Building teacher capability to use Technology to differentiate and improve learning experiences
- Building the capacity of Instructional Leaders through internal and external providers
- Building students capacity to make connections in learning by broadening their experience of the world outside Kilcoy

Purchase more Guidance Officer time to support students wellbeing and achievement	\$35 000
Purchasing Teacher Aide hours to support the school Literacy/Numeracy – Learning Support programs	\$36 000
Providing professional learning opportunities for Leaders, Teachers and Teacher Aides to build capacity to provide targeted and differentiated learning opportunities for all students	\$20 000
Purchase more time for Master Teacher to support students in Literacy/Numeracy/Innovation and Learning	\$33 000
Investing in technology, digital resources and services to build capability across the whole school to use these resources to facilitate the differentiation of learning	\$48 000
Purchasing and developing resources to enable the implementation of whole school and targeted programs	\$10 000
Providing equal access to targeted learning experiences in the wider community	\$10 000
NPDL Global Project participation – including membership, PD (Incl. Global Conference) and equipment and resources	\$12 000
