This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard for Literacy and Numeracy for their year level to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands.
- Increase the percentage of year 12 Students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education from 77% in 2014 to 95% in 2015; - and
- Have an evidence based plan, developed by the school, in place to address the specific learning needs of students not meeting the National Minimum Standard for Literacy and/or Numeracy

Our strategy will be to

- Develop and implement a 'Whole school approach' to provide a continuum of Literacy/Numeracy support with personalised teaching and intervention that meets the needs of all students.
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension across learning areas.
- Better prepare and support teacher aides to consolidate student learning in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning.
- Provide professional development opportunities for teachers across all learning areas in the teaching of Reading, Reading Comprehension, Writing and Numeracy Strategies.
- Continue to embed and support professional learning communities of school leaders and teachers to share and evaluate strategies and their impact, and explore opportunities to establish professional learning communities with cluster and like schools.
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning.
- Build the capacity of Instructional Leaders of the school through internal and external providers.

Purchase Teacher Aide hours to support the schools Literacy and Numeracy, and Learning Support programs.	\$26 000
